## Fruit Tree Pollination

### Pear Pollination

- I** **Incompatible** - will not cross pollinate.
- T** **Timing Compatible** - will cross pollinate provided conditions are suitable and blossom coincides.
- C** **Compatible** - will cross pollinate provided conditions are suitable.
- S** **Self-fertile** - does not need another pollinator but does require correct conditions and pollen transfer.
- P** **Partially Self-fertile** - may not need another pollinator but does require correct conditions and pollen transfer.
